

Fire & Evacuation Procedure

If Fire Breaks Out

- The first consideration must be the safety of the children.
- Raise the alarm by blowing the 'Fire Whistle'.
- Check all rooms, toilets, corners etc. for children & staff.
- Close doors & windows and turn electrical equipment off.
- Using nearest exit lead the children out.
- Fire Officer pick up register and call 999.
- In a safe place clear of the building:
 - The Register is taken, and missing children or staff reported to the fire officer.
 - No-one re-enters the building until permission is given to do so.
 - Then, if safe attempt to put out the fire but only using the specialist equipment provided - a fire blanket and fire extinguisher can be found in the kitchen and other fire extinguishers can be found by every exit and in the office.

If there is not a safe place clear of the building, the assembly point is GRAFTON SQUARE PLAYGROUND.

Remember: First Aid Box, EpiPens & Medication, Register, Emergency Contact file, Key, Mobile Phone and personal mobile phones!

To Call the Fire Brigade

- Lift the receiver and dial '999'
- Give operator your telephone number (landline: 020 7498 0319) and ask for **Fire**
- When Fire Brigade replies state: 'Fire at Maranatha Ministries: The Willow Nursery, 55 Grafton Square, London, SW4 0DE'
- Do not replace the receiver until address has been repeated.

Write up in Fire Record Book. Fire Drill practice carried out twice termly and is recorded.
